



Does the base station use an external or internal power supply

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The internal battery of the receiver is always being charged, and acts as an uninterruptible power supply if there is a power failure.

We have selected the Galaxy DX2547 first, as this is the only base station radio that we offer that will plug directly into your wall outlet. You can choose to get a mobile CB radio, like the DX959B, but will ...

When you use an external power supply, the integrated battery provides a backup power supply, enabling you to maintain continuous operation through a mains power failure. Cell phone towers can ...

It's nice to have a clean high end power supply that stays rock steady at 13.8v but in a pinch just about anything will work, including as others have said, a basic battery.

If you don't need the illuminated voltage and current meters you can find this 35 amp power supply for about \$140 or so, I think. It's nicely built but you do hear the fan when it turns on.

A lot of base station radios do not have a built-in power supply. A power supply will have a rating, usually expressed in Amps, which tells you how many amps it can provide.
