Solar PV installed capacity The global installed solar PV capacity over the past ten years and the contributions of the top fourteen countries are presented in Table 3, Table 4 (IRENA, 2023). Europe was the leading contributor to global solar PV projects in the early years of solar PV development.

What percentage of Japan's electricity comes from solar?

Solar made up 11 % of Japan's electricity mix in 2023 -- about double the global average. It's now one of 33 countries that get more than 10 % of their power from solar, including Chile (20 %), Australia (17 %), and Spain (17 %).

How many countries have not engaged in solar energy development?

Finally, within the group of 235 countries, it's seen that 30 nations, comprising around 12.8% of the total, have yet to engage in solar energy development. These 30 countries collectively have a population of 44 million. Out of these 30 countries, 23 (approximately 76.7%) have not documented any academic research in the field of solar energy.
