Can solar panels withstand hail?

"Most Tier 1 panels are tested to endure wind speeds up to 140 mph, and hail impact from 1-inch diameter hailstones traveling over 50 mph." Companies like UL Solutions, an applied safety science company, test solar panels by dropping a two-inch solid steel sphere from 51 inches onto panels, simulating the impact energy of serious hail.

Are solar panels fragile?

Solar panels aren't as fragile as some homeowners imagine. They're built to last, with tempered glass shields that can take a beating. "Modern solar panels are engineered to withstand extreme weather," Duane Wright of Fuse Solar and Roofing told Energysage.
