Where is Sri Jayewardenepura Kotte located?

Sri Jayewardenepura Kotte, city and legislative capital of Sri Lanka. It is located in the southwestern part of the country, about 5 miles (8 km) southeast of the commercial capital of Colombo, of which it was once a suburb. An urban council governs Sri Jayewardenepura Kotte and the neighbouring town of Nugegoda.

Kotta Raja Maha Viharaya The Kotte Raja Maha Viharaya was built by Parakramabahu VI in 1415. This Viharaya contained frescoes that were created in the 15th century. The Viharaya was completely ruined by the Portuguese and Dutch during their invasions and was restored later on.
