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Will China build a wind farm in Uzbekistan?

Source: Xinhua |2025-04-10 21:31:30 |Editor: huaxia TASHKENT, April 10 (Xinhua) -- A Chinese-built wind farm project in Uzbekistan-- the largest of its kind in Central Asia -- has begun commercial operations two months ahead of schedule.

Who owns BASH & dzhankeldy wind farms?

Located in the Bukhara region, the Bash and Dzhankeldy wind farms project was jointly invested in, built and operated by Saudi Arabia-based energy company ACWA Power (with 65 percent stake), and China Southern Power Grid (CSG) International (Hong Kong) Co., Ltd. (with 35 percent stake). The total installed capacity is 1.027 million kilowatts.

How many kilowatts is China's new wind power plant?

The total installed capacity is 1.027 million kilowatts. "To adapt to the volatile local climate, the project adopted China's homegrown 6.5 MW large-capacity wind turbines.

Where is PPPA project located in Uzbekistan?

The proposed project site is in the Karatau mountain region in Beruniy and Qorao'zak Districts in Karakalpakstan, Northwestern Uzbekistan. A 25-year PPPA has been awarded to ACWA through a competitive tender and signed on March 28, 2024, with the National Electric Grid of Uzbekistan (NEGU) as the Public Partner (off taker).
