PV1 current is 7amps PV2 is 3.7 Similarly, (and assuming panels are all facing the same direction and there's no shading from trees or structures on the roof) the input with double the current ...

The maximum PV input power for both PV1 and PV2 is 7000W. In other words, PV1= max 3500W, PV2= max 3500W. What are the other issues you are having with the inverter?

A photovoltaic (PV) system is composed of one or more solar panels combined with an inverter and other electrical and mechanical hardware that use energy from the Sun to generate electricity.

But I would connect 4 panels in series PV1+ and PV1- and the other 4 the same way on PV2+ and PV2-. But do note that your panels may barely reach sufficient power at peak sun.

The solar inverter does the important job of changing DC power from the panels into AC power for your home. The PV Input is the entry point on the inverter where the DC power from the ...
