Which countries produce the most wind energy?

The top five markets account for 72.2% and 93.1% of cumulative installed capacity for onshore and offshore wind energy (GWEC, 2022, Table 1 below). China, which became the world's largest wind energy market in 2010 (Blackwell, 2018: 122), now accounts for 51% of newly installed capacity.
